

Circuit Letter October 2020

If and when we move from Tier 1 into Tier 2 or 3, that means that the numbers of people being affected by Covid-19 is increasing at an alarming rate. The CLT believes that when this happens we have a moral obligation to play our part in helping to keep opportunities for cross contamination to a minimum and one of the ways to do this is to cease public worship until we revert to Tier 1.

Recognising that it may be possible for one part of the circuit to enter a higher Tier whilst another part of the circuit remains in Tier 1, the CLT request that, as a circuit we respond collectively to any increase which means if any one part of the circuit enters a higher rate all churches cease public worship.

In the mean-time we make our plans on the understanding that plans may change but there is one who never changes 'Jesus Christ, the same yesterday, today and forever.' Hebrews 13:8.
